On July 27, 2012, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety, issued to Buckeye Partners, L.P. (Buckeye) a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order.

Please be advised, we reviewed your quarterly reports that you submitted in accordance with the requirements set forth in this Compliance Order. We also reviewed your letter dated April 11, 2014 wherein you stated that Buckeye's Line 742 crossing the Delaware River was abandoned on January 16, 2014 (inadvertently dated January 16, 2004). Pursuant to Item 5 of this Compliance Order, after Buckeye has abandoned said portion of the pipeline, Buckeye will not be required to comply with the other terms of this Compliance Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
