During the week of November 28, 2011, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Spectra Energy Transmission, LLC's (Spectra) procedures for its Algonquin Gas Transmission Corporation (AGT) facilities located in New Jersey. As a result of the inspection, Spectra was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on April 6, 2012.
