During the week of March 26, 2012, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company's procedures in White Haven, PA. As a result of the inspection, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 24, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
