On October 22, 2012, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety issued to Enterprise Products Operating, LLC (Enterprise) a Final Order (FO) in the above-referenced case. The FO included an assessed civil penalty and a Compliance Order (CO).

The PHMSA Southern Region received and reviewed the documents Enterprise provided with regards to the CO. Based on our review of this documentation and our confirmation that Enterprise has paid the civil penalty, we have determined that Enterprise has complied with the terms of the FO and CO. Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is necessary with respect to the matters involved in this case.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to the above described order (**CPF 2-2011-5012**) and not to any other PHMSA pending cases. Also be advised that nothing herein states or implies that the Enterprise pipeline system meets the requirements of the federal pipeline safety regulations. The Enterprise pipeline system remains subject to inspection by PHMSA.
