Dear Mr. Rose:

On November 8-10, 2011, and March 22, 2012, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Southern Region, Office of Pipeline Safety inspected the Tampa Airport Pipeline Corporation (TAPC) Pipeline Integrity Management Plan (IMP) in Tampa, Florida, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code. As a result of the inspection, the Southern Region issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) to TAPC on October 2, 2012.

The Southern Region granted one 53-day extension on December 18, 2012, for TAPC to provide revised procedures. Subsequent to that grant of extension, we received and reviewed three responses to the NOA dated January 23, 2013, April 12, 2013, and August 9, 2013. In each case we identified additional deficiencies.

We received and reviewed your latest response to the NOA dated September 23, 2013. This letter is to inform you that TAPC has complied with the terms of the NOA and that no further action is necessary with regards to the NOA. This case is now closed.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to the NOA (CPF 2-2012-6018M) and not to any other PHMSA pending cases.
