Dear Mr. Lemoi:

On August 16, 2013, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Southern Region, Office of Pipeline Safety inspected records concerning Rentech's 6-inch pipeline operated by Enmark Energy, Inc. (Enmark).

As a result of the inspection, it appears that Enmark has committed probable violations of the Pipeline Safety Regulation, Title 49, Code of Federal Regulation and PHMSA proposes to issue a Compliance Order to Enmark per letter dated October 25, 2013 to Enmark.

Enmark is not contesting the proposed compliance order but is seeking modification of the proposed compliance order. Enmark submitted to Rentech the letter dated October 25, 2013 from PHMSA to Enmark which included the Proposed Compliance Order and Response Options for Pipeline Operators in Compliance Proceedings. Rentech reviewed the information and has conveyed to Enmark that Rentech has definitely decided to immediately proceed with abandonment of this subject pipeline through the FERC permitting process.

Enmark request the proposed compliance order be modified due to the fact that the subject pipeline is in the process of being abandoned. Enmark will provide PHMSA in a timely manner a copy of Rentech's FERC abandonment application and the docket number so PHMSA can track the progress of the abandonment. Please review this request and Enmark will comply with PHMSA findings.
