On February 20, 2007, the Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Kaneb Pipe Line Company/Valero, L.P. a Final Order in the above-referenced case. NuStar Energy, LP. is the current operator responsive to this Order. The Order included a Compliance Order to provide a remediation plan, schedule, and evaluate each pipeline crossing with foreign pipeline crossings for adverse effects of stray currents on your Mandan, ND to Roseville, MN pipeline. Based on a review of the documentation you provided on October 23, 2006, and January 24, 2011, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of this Order.
