Dear Tom Saunders:

On December 12-14, 2009 and January 25-26, 2010, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Quest Pipeline (Quest) [now PostRock Pipeline] procedures in Olathe, Kansas. As a result of the inspection, Quest Pipeline was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 23, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Quest submitted amended procedures on October 19, 2010 and, January 5, 2011. PostRock Pipeline submitted an additional procedure on April 13, 2011. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
