Please accept this follow up to your inquiry of March 5, 2007, concerning the above referenced Compliance Action with Black Hills Operating Company. The CPF deals with findings from an inspection of BHOC's Operator Qualification Program conducted by the Southwest, Southern, and Western Regions/Office of Pipeline Safety and the Railroad Commission of Texas.

Sunoco Pipeline LP (SPLP) acquired pipeline assets in the State of Texas from Black Hills Operating Company on March 1, 2006. These assets included the Kilgore pipeline system and the Millennium pipeline system. The Kilgore pipeline system is an intrastate pipeline subject to the Texas Railroad Commission's jurisdiction while the Millennium pipeline system is interstate and subject to DOT/OPS jurisdiction.

Sunoco Pipeline operates the acquired assets with Sunoco Pipeline personnel. These personnel are covered by Sunoco Pipeline L.P. and Affiliates Operator Qualification Plan. No personnel from BHOC were retained in positions subject to Operator Qualification requirements. Therefore no actions were required by SPLP in response to deficiencies noted in CPF 4-2005-5027.
