On October 22, 2014, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an investigation related to the natural gas incident that occurred in Newport, Arkansas. As a result of the investigation, a Final Order was issued on April 29, 2016 to Enable Mississippi River Transmission, LLC (EMRT) requiring amendments to their Damage Prevention procedures regarding the tracking and tracing of line locate requests.

EMRT submitted its amended procedures on July 11, 2016. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Final Order have been corrected and payment of the penalty has been made.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
