On June 8 – 11, 2010, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Chevron Pipe Line Company's procedures for operations, maintenance, and emergency response in Lakewood, Colorado. As a result of the inspection, Chevron was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 21, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
