On September 26 through 29, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Devon Gas Service's (Devon) integrity management program procedures in Riverton, Wyoming. As a result of the inspection, Devon was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 19, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Devon responded to the Notice of Amendment on May 23, 2012. In its response, Devon contested the alleged inadequacies outlined in the Notice and explained how its procedures address them. My staff has reviewed Devon's response and procedures, and it appears that they adequately address the allegations.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
