Between July 20 and November 6, 2015, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Hilcorp Alaska, LLC's (Hilcorp) procedures for the Liquid Operations and Maintenance Manual in Anchorage, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, Hilcorp was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on March 17, 2016, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Hilcorp submitted its amended procedures on April 26, 2016. PHMSA staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the NOA have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed.
