On November 7-10, 2011, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) inspected the ExxonMobil US Production (XOM) Operations, Maintenance and Emergency Manual for Natural Gas Pipelines (OMER) written procedures in Theodore, Alabama, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code. As a result of the inspection, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on February 9, 2012.

The PHMSA Southern Region received your response to the NOA on March 14, 2012. We have reviewed your response, and find XOM's response adequate. This letter is to inform you that XOM has complied with the terms of the NOA and that no further action is necessary with regards to the NOA. This case is now closed.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to the NOA (CPF 2-2012-2002M) and not to any other PHMSA pending cases. Also be advised that nothing herein states or implies that the above described OMER meets the requirements of the federal pipeline safety regulations or that the OMER is approved. The pipeline system and OMER remain subject to inspection by PHMSA.
