

Dear Mr. Seeley:

TransMontaigne has received your Notice of Amendment dated February 7, 2008.

TransMontaigne completed the purchase of the Penn Octane – Rio Vista assets located in Cameron County, Texas on December 31, 2007. TransMontaigne will move these assets from its stand-alone Integrity Management Plan to the TransMontaigne Integrity Management Plan. The TPSI plan was audited on December 5-6, 2006 by the Southern Region, and modifications were made as required for items cited in CPF-2-2007-6005M.

In moving these assets to the TPSI plan, we will review and make modifications as noted in CPF 4-2008-5005M. We will provide these issues to Bill Bertges, our consultant to insure that these items are adequately addressed in our current plan and provide copies of changes to your office for review.

The review and modification process may exceed the thirty-day requirement but we hope to have these issue closed no later than March 31, 2008 if this meets with your approval.
