During the dates of July 30 – August 3, 2012, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Western Refining procedures for the control room management in Bloomfield, New Mexico. As a result of the inspection, Western Refining was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 13, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
