On March 29 through April 2, 2010, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Questar Gas Management's (Questar) procedures in Granger, Wyoming. As a result of the inspection, Questar was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 22, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures

Questar submitted its amended procedures on September 30, 2010. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
