On March 8-9, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of TransCanada procedures in Omaha, Nebraska. As a result of the inspection, TransCanada was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 21, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
