Between July 2012 and October 2012, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of your Operations and Maintenance (O&M) procedures and records of the Powder River and Borger-to-Denver systems at your headquarter in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 3, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC submitted its amended procedures on November 21, 2013. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
