Between April and July 2010, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) inspected Cameron Interstate Pipeline, LLC (CIP) Integrity Management Program. As a result of the inspection, CIP was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 14, 2011. This Notice proposed amendment of your procedures to assure safe operation of your pipeline facilities.
