From September 4 - 7, 2012, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Sunoco Pipeline L.P.'s (Sunoco) procedures in Trenton, New Jersey. As a result of this inspection, Sunoco was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 29, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Sunoco submitted its amended procedures on January 13, 2014. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
