Pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA"), through its agent the State Inspectors of the New York State Department of Public Service ("NYPS"), conducted an audit of Iroquois Gas Transmission System, L.P. ("Iroquois"). The audit was conducted between June 22, 2015 and June 26, 2015. On August 6, 2015, Iroquois received a Notice of Amendment ("Notice"). In the Notice, PHMSA identified inadequacies with Iroquois procedure 479-A-01, Rev. 4, dated 4/4/14 in that the procedure did not specify time frames for remediating deficiencies.

Immediately following the inspection Iroquois modified its procedure to include time frames for remediating deficiencies and on July 1, 2015 sent a copy of the draft revision to the NYPS. Iroquois has completed the management of change process and issued Rev. 5 of 479-A-01 dated August 4, 2015 (see attached). On the basis of Iroquois' modification of the procedure, Iroquois hereby requests that PHMSA find that the terms of the compliance order in this case have been satisfied and requests that PHMSA close this case

Iroquois has been and remains committed to the safety of the public, its assets and people as well as a culture of compliance.
