On August 21-22, 2012, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Toledo Refining Company, LLC's (Toledo's) procedures for Public Awareness Program Effectiveness in Oregon, OH.
