Re: PHMSA Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order (CPF 4-2015-1007)
Notice of Amendment (CPF 402015-1008M)

Dear Mr. Seeley:

American Midstream Partners, LP ("American Midstream") received certified letters on April 28, 2015, from the Southwest Region of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA") including the Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order ("NOPV") and Notice of Amendment ("NOA") captioned above. For the reasons stated below, we are writing to request a one-month extension to fully respond to the NOPV and NOA, to and until June 26, 2015.

At this time, American Midstream does not intend to contest any of the items listed in the NOPV or NOA. However, American Midstream is working to ensure compliance with PHMSA statutes and regulations and intends to provide written information and/or explanations regarding the allegations. Based on our cooperation during the June 2014 PHMSA inspection and forthcoming submittals, we request consideration for mitigation of the penalty referenced in the NOPV.

American Midstream requests this extension to allow sufficient time to fully evaluate the NOPV and NOA and prepare a full and complete response. We are striving to achieve continuous improvement and full compliance on all points raised in the PHMSA notices. To assist in this response, American Midstream has retained an outside consultant to review and evaluate its recordkeeping procedures and compliance with the NOPV, as well as American Midstream's Control Room Management Plan. The additional time is necessary to allow American Midstream's consultant to complete this review and prepare a comprehensive response to deficiencies alleged by PHMSA.

American Midstream received the NOPV and NOA on April 28, 2015, so the original deadline for responding would be May 28, 2015. American Midstream respectfully requests that the deadline be extended to Friday June 26, 2015. We would appreciate a written response confirming whether the proposed extension has been approved.
