Dear Ms. McDaniel:

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued the above referenced Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) to Texas Eastern Transmission, LP (TETLP) on December 9, 2020, alleging one (1) violation. TETLP timely responded to the NOPV, contesting the alleged violation and proposed civil penalty, and requesting a hearing. At the same time, TETLP requested the opportunity to meet with PHMSA to attempt to resolve the issues without resort to a hearing.

Following the submission of additional information and several meetings between the parties, TETLP and PHMSA reached an agreement to resolve the matter as reflected in the attached Consent Agreement and Order that the parties entered into, effective April 8, 2021. Given the memorialization of the parties' agreement in the Consent Agreement and Order, TETLP hereby withdraws its Request for Hearing regarding the above referenced NOPV without admitting to any allegation or conclusion in the NOPV.
