From September 23, 2019 to September 26, 2019, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Chevron Pipeline Company's (Chevron) procedures in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Chevron was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 15, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Chevron submitted its amended procedures on February 6, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
