Dear Mr. Ramsey:

From May 10, 2021 through May 13, 2021, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Energy Transfer Company's (ETC) Integrity Management Plan (IMP) procedures for its gas facilities. As a result of the inspection, Energy Transfer was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on December 1, 2021, which proposed amendments to its procedures.

After being granted a time extension for its response to the Notice, ETC submitted its amended procedures on February 14, 2022. PHMSA staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
