Dear Mr. True:

On April 2, 2009, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Bridger Pipeline Company (Bridger) a Final Order on CPF 5-2007-5003. Bridger subsequently filed a petition for reconsideration and on June 16, 2009 PHMSA issued a Decision on that petition for reconsideration and a Compliance Order.

During the time period that the Final Order was being developed, there was a "whistle blower" concern relating to previous sleeve repairs associated with this case. To address this issue, Bridger re-excavated a previously repaired sleeve and, in the presence of PHMSA personnel, performed a non-destructive test (NDT) on that sleeve's welds. These welds had previously been NDT'ed as a requirement of the Compliance Order. The whistle blower concerns with these welds were not observed on this weld, but some minor visual flaws were discovered which were subsequently repaired and then NDT'ed again. Based on our review of the documentation you provided, it has been determined that you have now complied with the terms of this Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
