From October 20 to 21, 2009, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Omimex Canada's (Omimex) procedures for operation and maintenance of the Chinook Pipeline located north of Chinook, Montana. As a result of the inspection, Omimex was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on May 17, 2010 which proposed amendment of your procedures.
