Dear Mr. Belden:

On March 21, 2011, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Colonial Pipeline Company (Colonial) a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order and Civil Penalty assessment. The Compliance Order set forth remedial requirements to ensure pipeline safety.

Colonial submitted a draft report of effort regarding this Order to PHMSA on July 22, 2011. Subsequently, on January 17, 2012, Colonial submitted a final summary report that demonstrated compliance with all the requirements outlined in the Compliance Order.

A Virginia State Corporation Commission (VA SCC) Inspector, as an agent for PHMSA, observed portions of the Close Interval Survey (CIS) that Colonial performed in accordance with this Order. The VA SCC also reviewed Colonial's final summary report submission.

Based on our review of the documentation provided and confirmation of payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that Colonial has complied with the terms of this Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
