Between September 25, 2007 and August 8, 2008, a State Inspector from the Virginia State Corporation Commission (VA SCC) acting as Agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of City of Richmond's (City) procedures in Richmond, Virginia. As a result of the inspection, the City was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 13, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
