Dear Mr. McGill:

Between October 14 and December 10, 2008, a State Inspector from the New York Public Service Commission (NY PSC), acting as an Agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Enbridge Energy Partners, L.P. (Enbridge) procedures in Buffalo, NY. As a result of the inspection, Enbridge was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 23, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Enbridge submitted its amended procedures on October 22, 2010, and a supplemental submittal on April 14, 2011 (via electronic transmission). My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
