From September 21 through 24, 2009, representatives of New York State Department of Public Service (NYSDPS), acting as agents for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation's facility (CGT), which is a subsidiary of NiSource Gas Transmission & Storage, in Binghamton, New York. As a result of the inspection, CGT was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 22, 2011, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
