Between January 27 and December 29, 2011 inspectors from the Virginia State Corporation Commission (VA SCC) acting as Agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected the City of Danville's (City) pipeline facilities in Danville, VA including City operations and maintenance (O&M) procedures.
