On December 20, 2012, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety, issued to Columbia Gas Transmission, L.L.C. (Columbia) a Corrective Action Order following a pipeline rupture and fire that occurred on its SM-80 pipeline in Sissonville, West Virginia. This Order included requirements to take corrective actions on the SM-80 pipeline from Lanham Station to the Broad Run Meter facility.
