From October 11 to October 13, 2011, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Iroquois Gas Corporation's (Iroquois) procedures for Control Room Management in Shelton, Connecticut. As a result of the inspection, Iroquois was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on July 12, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Iroquois submitted its amended procedures on August 12, 2013 and January 8, 2014. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice have been corrected.
