From July 12-14, 2011, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected the National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation's (National Fuel) Public Awareness Program in Erie, Pennsylvania. As a result of the inspection, National Fuel was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on November 26, 2013.

On December 20, 2013, National Fuel submitted its initial response to the NOA. On February 24, 2014, National Fuel completed its submission of amended procedures. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies set forth in the NOA have been corrected.
