Between August 27 and 31, 2012, inspectors from New York State Department of Public Service (NYSDPS), acting as agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), inspected New York State Electric & Gas's (operated by Arlington Storage Company, LLC) public awareness program (PAP).

As a result of this inspection, PHMSA Eastern Region issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) to Inergy Midstream on November 26, 2013.

Arlington Storage Company, LLC (ASC) submitted amended procedures on March 10, 2014, April 3, 2015, and August 14, 2015.

My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
