During the week of August 13, 2012, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration and the New York Department of Public Service, pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Sunoco Pipeline's (Sunoco) procedures in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. As a result of the inspection, Sunoco was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 16, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Sunoco submitted its amended procedures on April 9, 2014. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
