From March 11 to April 5, 2013, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected the Dominion Transmission, Inc.
