During the week of October 27, 2014, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of BP USFO/Logistics' (BP) procedures in Carteret, NJ. As a result of the inspection, BP was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 1, 2015, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
