During the week of November 17, 2014, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of PPL Interstate Energy Co's (PPL) procedures in Pottstown, PA. As a result of the inspection, PPL was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 22, 2015, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
