On October 22, 2015, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued an Amended Corrective Action Order (ACAO) with regard to a pipeline failure accident of Colonial Pipeline Company (Colonial). The ACAO included a list of various required Corrective Actions.

We have received an email and ACAO Documentation Report dated March 31, 2020, from a representative of Colonial. The Documentation Report was submitted as part of the final Corrective Action deliverable. Simultaneously, the correspondence requested closure of the ACAO.
