On April 29 of 2016, and on July 19, 2016, PHMSA issued a Corrective Action Order (CAO) and an Amended Corrective Action Order (ACAO), respectively, with regard to a pipeline failure incident of your subsidiary, Texas Eastern Transmission, LP. The ACAO included a list of various required Corrective Actions.

We have received a letter and CAO Documentation Report dated July 8, 2019 from Mr. Rick Kivela, Manager, Operational Compliance. The Documentation Report was submitted as part of the final Corrective Action deliverable, required under item 10 of the ACAO. Subsequently, a letter from Mr. Kivela was received on September 3, 2019 requesting closure of the ACAO.

Based on our review of the documentation, it has been determined that Texas Eastern Transmission, LP has complied with the terms of the order.
