Between February 22-26, 2016, inspectors from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CT DEEP), acting as agents for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Total Peaking Services' (TPS) procedures, records, and LNG plant facilities in Milford, CT. As a result of the inspection, TPS was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 22, 2016, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
