Dear Mr. Kivela:

On August 1 and 2, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Texas Eastern Transmission, LP's (TETLP), a subsidiary of Enbridge Inc., Lebanon Extension in Pennsylvania. As a result of the inspection, TETLP was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on October 30, 2017, which alleged inadequacies in your procedures.

Enbridge, on behalf of its subsidiary, responded to the inadequacies alleged in the NOA on November 28, 2017, and submitted applicable procedures that were not previously provided during the inspection. Enbridge also requested a telephonic hearing to be scheduled at a mutually agreeable time. My staff has completed its review of the procedures that were submitted, and it appears that the procedures address the issues identified in the NOA.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. The need for a hearing is now moot. Thank you for your cooperation.
