Dear Mr. Cluff:

Between May 23, 2016 and October 28, 2016, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), and inspectors from the New York State Department of Public Service (NYS DPS), acting as agents of PHMSA, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code performed an integrated inspection of Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company's (Transco) Princeton and Charlottesville Divisions, located throughout Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, Maryland, Delaware, Virginia, North Carolina and South Carolina.

As a result of the inspection, Transco was issued a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV), Proposed Civil Penalty, and Proposed Compliance Order on January 18, 2018. A Final Order was issued on April 12, 2019.

Based on our review of the documentation Transco provided on June 12, 2019, and confirmation of payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of the Final Order.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
