From August 15–17, 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Williams – Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company’s (Williams) procedures for Station 240, Carlstadt LNG Facility in Carlstadt, NJ. As a result of the inspection, Williams was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 26, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Williams submitted its amended procedures on December 6, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
