Dear Mr. Scaraggi:

From July 17–21, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Distrigas of Massachusetts LLC's (Distrigas) maintenance procedures for the Everett Marine Terminal in Everett, Massachusetts.

As a result of the inspection, Distrigas was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) dated April 2, 2018. In response to the NOA, Distrigas requested a hearing and statement of issues on April 30, 2018. On May 29, 2018 Distrigas met with PHMSA in Trenton, New Jersey for an informal meeting. On June 21, 2018 Distrigas withdrew its request for hearing and submitted revised procedures. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
