From March 27 to 31 of 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of Title 49 of the United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Sunoco Pipeline L.P.'s procedures in Hopedale, Ohio. As a result of the inspection, Sunoco Pipeline L.P. was issued a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) and Proposed Compliance Order (PCO) on January 11, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Sunoco Pipeline L.P. submitted its amended procedures on December 7, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
